Induction Evening:

Parents of children currently in Year 3, 4 & 5 are invited to our **Induction Evening on Tuesday 10th July** to meet your child's new teacher and hear about the curriculum, routines and expectations for your child's new year group. Please note the children currently in years 3 & 5 will be mixed into new class groups for next year.

One meeting will be held at 4.30pm then repeated at 5.15pm to give parents a choice of times and to attend more than one year group meeting if necessary. Children are of course also welcome to attend.

Change to the School Day:

In order to bring teaching hours in line within the Waycroft MAT, from September we will be making a change to the school day.

To ensure parents with children in both Wicklea and St Anne's Infants are not negatively impacted we are making the change to the start of the school day rather than the end of the day.

From September the school doors will open at 8:50am rather than 8:45am and registration will be at 9.00am rather than 8.55am. Breakfast club will continue to open at 7:55am until the doors close at 8:30am.

Playground Development:

Currently the grassed area is not fit for PE lessons and during the winter months cannot be used during playtimes. We are therefore developing a large area of the field during the summer holidays to install artificial grass, which will include markings for a small running track and other sports.

With growing pupil numbers this will provide more space for playtimes all year around and an extra space for multiple PE lessons ta take place at the same time.
