In order for you to be able to order school lunches from next term please remember to create your **ParentPay** account as soon as possible. The recently issued letter contained your unique user name and password. ParentPay will help Wicklea become a cashless school as future trips, residential camps, swimming lessons, etc. will also be paid for on line. If you have any problems

The **School Library** continues to be very popular with 80% of pupils already having borrowed a book. Many children have borrowed a book more than once – in fact 474 books have been borrowed in just over four weeks! The **travelling book fair** was also a great success, raising commission of £252, which we can spend on books. This will be used to add to the reading corners in each year group. Thank you to the Friends for their help with the book fair.



We are currently working towards recognition as a **Rights Respecting School**. This is an award which is given to schools on behalf of UNICEF. In 1989, the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child was adopted. These rights are based on what a child needs to survive, grow and fulfil their potential. This will help our pupils become more caring and responsible citizens,

both at school, and within the wider community. As such, last Monday, we held a launch morning, with lots of activities to introduce this to the children. Please discuss this with your children at home, further helping them understand that having rights and responsibilities is not just for children in schools, but also every single person in the world. During the week commencing 28<sup>th</sup> September each class held elections for their **school councillors.** In addition, every child in each house attended a 'House Assembly' where Year 6 children put their case forward to become House Captain. The School Council will attend regular meetings with Mr Hazard and Miss Moffat. They have already held their first meeting providing feedback on how playtimes could be improved further by purchasing new equipment and developing the playground. I will be following up these ideas in the coming weeks and months.

Since the last newsletter Year 6 and Year 4 have been away on **residential camp.** I know both year groups represented the school fantastically well and thoroughly enjoyed the variety of activities on offer. If your child is currently in Year 3 or Year 5 look out for the residential camp information evenings, which will be held later in the year. The 'How Are We Doing' meeting held on Monday 12<sup>th</sup> October was very well attended. Thank you to those parents who came along. If you were unable to attend the following is a summary of the main points discussed:

- It was agreed that as many Inset days as • possible will be the same as the infants school
- The Local Governing Body will explore the demand for an after school club
- Communication has improved, e.g. text messages each day that children were away on camps. The next stage to develop upon communication is the school website
- The school wide Rights Respecting Schools • behaviour system was explained - this will be included in the next Year 2 induction meeting
- It was confirmed that swimming now only • takes place in Year 3 (with the exception of catch up lessons in the summer for Year 5 & 6 children who cannot yet swim 25 metres)
- There were many positive comments shared • surrounding a variety of topics including: curriculum breadth, single age classes, after school clubs, residential camps and the variety of rewards available (house points, certificates, awards, trophies, etc)
- It was agreed future meetings will also be held in the evenings for working parents

Friday 13<sup>th</sup> November is **Children In Need Day**. To raise funds for this worthwhile cause we will be hosting a film night in the hall after school (3:30-5:30). Big Hero 6 (rated PG) will be shown on our giant screen, with popcorn and squash being provided. Entry will be £2 per child (Wicklea pupils only) and all profits will go to Children In Need. Tickets are not required – you will be

able to pay and sign your child into the showing straight after school.

Please remember to provide your child with a water bottle for use in class as it is extremely important to keep hydrated throughout the day. Please note if your child has a packed lunch it is a good idea to include a drink with their lunch as water bottles are kept in classrooms during the school day.
