Dear Mothers, Fathers, Carers and Local Residents

Parking in and around the school has become a lot busier in recent weeks, particularly in the lane next to the school. Please do not park opposite a parked car in the lane as it can block access for school kitchen deliveries and access for local residents. I have recently met with local residents and Bristol City Council to find a workable solution to this problem.

During parent's evenings I issued a questionnaire regarding the demand for paid after school provision. This way I was able to ensure the maximum number of parents received the questionnaire (94% of parents attended over the two evenings).

The feedback showed that the demand for such provision is very low with only 4.5% of parents stating that they were very likely to use a club. This was presented to the local governing body, who decided that given the small number of parents stating an interest, we will not currently be offering such provision at our school.



With effect from Friday 4<sup>th</sup> December we will be serving bacon rolls and showing a film each Friday during breakfast club. Bacon rolls will cost 80 pence each.

On Monday 16<sup>th</sup> November a representative from the One Tree Per Child initiative gave an assembly to the whole school. With Bristol being the European Green Capital this year the One Tree aim is for a tree to be planted by every primary **Per Child** aged child in the city.

On December 9<sup>th</sup> fifteen children from each year group will also be selected to plant trees in the local woods with representatives from the project. Make sure you return your form by this date indicating which tree you would like. Trees are expected to be delivered in January.

I would like to say a very big thank you to all who helped prepare, set up and run the Christmas Fair last Friday (we made around £825). A lot of time and effort is given by parent volunteers and it is greatly appreciated. It was great to see so many staff helping on the day and several ex-pupils too.

I joined the Friends team several years ago, not knowing anyone. I've met some lovely people throughout the years and get a buzz from knowing the children benefit greatly from the funds we raise for the school and it's lovely to see so many happy faces at the events the Friends make possible. We can't do it without ongoing commitment and welcome new members & new ideas.
