Contact Details:

Please make sure we have up to date telephone numbers and an email address for you. The vast majority of our communications are sent electronically and it is crucial that we can telephone you in an emergency. If you have any changes to tell us of please email or pass a note to the office.

Care Plans & Medicines:

As it is a new school year we need to update care plans. If your child needs to have medicine regularly administered in school or is allergic to anything they must have a care plan. Evidence of any allergies must be supported by medical evidence. To administer any medicine in school, including inhalers, we must have a detailed and signed form. Please ask at the office for the forms required to update any care plans or set up a new one.

Breakfast Club:

All children are welcome at breakfast club from 8am onwards (doors close at 8:35am). You do not need to book in advance and entrance is free, on the assumption that food or drink is purchased. Adults and younger siblings are welcome to stay as well.

ParentPay:

We are a cashless school. All payments to school must be done via ParentPay. The only exception to this is for any external clubs that are being run. You can set up a ParentPay account and pay directly through this or alternatively pay via PayPoint. You will need to request a bar code from school in order to pay this way.
