Challenge Partners Review:

On the 15th, 16^h and 17^h March Wicklea underwent its second annual Challenge Partner Review. Challenge Partners is an association which visit schools all over the country. Two senior leaders from other schools worked alongside a registered OFSTED inspector to carry out our review. The review team were very impressed with many aspects of Wicklea as well as the improvements made against last year's suggestions. I am delighted to share that the review team graded Teaching & Learning & School Improvement Strategies as 'Good' and gave the school an overall grade of working within 'Good'. These judgements equate to the judgements made by senior leaders and are evidence of the school's continuing improvement. All staff and pupils should be proud of this achievement.
